Our next session consisted of me reviewing how to use RAZ kids and the importance of taking their time and paying attention to the stories that they are reading. The session following was a review of reading responses and what information should be included. The next session was teaching both students how to use and then going and making a reading response on the story read. I would periodically check in on the students work students would spend the last five minutes of stories on their reading level to use.
